NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Sikkim (Repeal and Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1985 the State Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Sikkim Trade License and Miscellaneous Provision Rules, 2011, namely:-

- Short title and Commencement: 1. (1) These rules may be called the Sikkim Trade License and Miscellaneous Provisions (Amendment) Rules, 2025.
(2) They shall come into force from the 1st day of April, 2025.
- Amendment of Schedule-I, II and III: 2. In the Sikkim Trade License and Miscellaneous Provision Rules, 2011, for existing Schedule-I, II and III, the following shall be substituted, namely: -
